### <u>Administrative</u> –

#### Standards Based Reporting - Part 2 -

Dr. Teater reviewed the District Foundational Principles:

- Instructional Content is fully aligned to Standards (Standards-aligned)
- Responsive teaching is used in all classes for all disciplines (Knowing your students)
- Teachers communicate each student's level of attainment of the standards (Assessment)

Dr. Teater explained what drives instruction:

- Teachers differentiation of instruction based on student abilities
- Textbooks presentation of material based on author'
- Standards content based on district's goals
- Community elects board of education who approve the above

### Standards-Based Grades lead to:

- Clearer, more purposeful instruction
- Clearer, more purposeful academic feedback
- Separates academics standards from behavior standards

Dr. Teater shared an example of a Reading report card/rubric example and a Habits of Success report card/rubric example.

Board members discussed the differences between letter grades and standards based grading. Dr. Teater noted that Morton School District has looked at different models being used by other school districts including Stephenson High School (SHS) in Lincolnshire, IL. SHS uses a hybrid model of standards based reporting with conversion to a letter grade. Dr. Teater will forward additional information to board members on Stephenson High School's grading procedures.

Board members commended Dr. Teater on his thorough presentation over the last two meetings. The entire presentation may be viewed on <u>MP-TV</u>.
