Approve Bids for Asbestos Removal at Morton High School -

The bid opening for the Morton High School Asbestos work was held on April 3, 2020. In conjunction with the Morton High School renovation of select areas, asbestos work is necessary. The work consists of removing asbestos-containing flooring and ceilings associated with the renovation of STEM labs, a conference room, a portion of a corridor and various classrooms.

Bids were received from four companies – Abel Plus Services, Inc., ARC Environmental, DEM Services, Inc., and Midwest Services. The base bids ranged from \$39,300 - \$59,840 with DEM Services, Inc. submitting the lowest bid.

The administration recommends that the Board of Education accept the bid from DEM Services, Inc. in the amount of \$39,300.
