Minutes of the Committee of the Whole Meeting of the Board of Education of Morton Unit School District 709 held September 1, 2015, at the Morton Education and Administration Center.

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING -

President Michelle Bernier called the Committee of the Whole meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Dr. Hall presented three new financing scenarios:

- #1 Issue \$3.235 million in Working Cash Bonds in 2016 7 years
 Issue \$5.1 million in Alternate Revenue Bonds in 2016 7 years
 Additional \$8.335 million spent on capital improvements in 2016
- #2 Issue \$3.235 million in Working Cash Bonds in 2016 7 years
 Transfer \$3 million from Working Cash Fund in 2016
 Put \$1.119 million of General State Aid in O & M Fund vs Ed. Fund in 2017
 Additional \$7.354 million spent on capital improvements in 2016
- #3 Issue \$3.235 million in Working Cash Bonds in 2016 7 years
 Transfer \$3 million from Working Cash Fund in 2016
 Put \$1.119 million of General State Aid in O & M vs Ed. Fund in 2017
 Drop 5 year maintenance capital spending to \$1 million/year
 Addition \$9.605 million spent on capital improvements in 2016

Discussion centered on Board members not wanting to go into debt and spend down the reserves for gyms and a few classrooms. It was suggested that phasing the urgent needs over the next few years would be a better solution. It was pointed out that the Board is still not in agreement on a long term plan for the Jr. High and High School.
